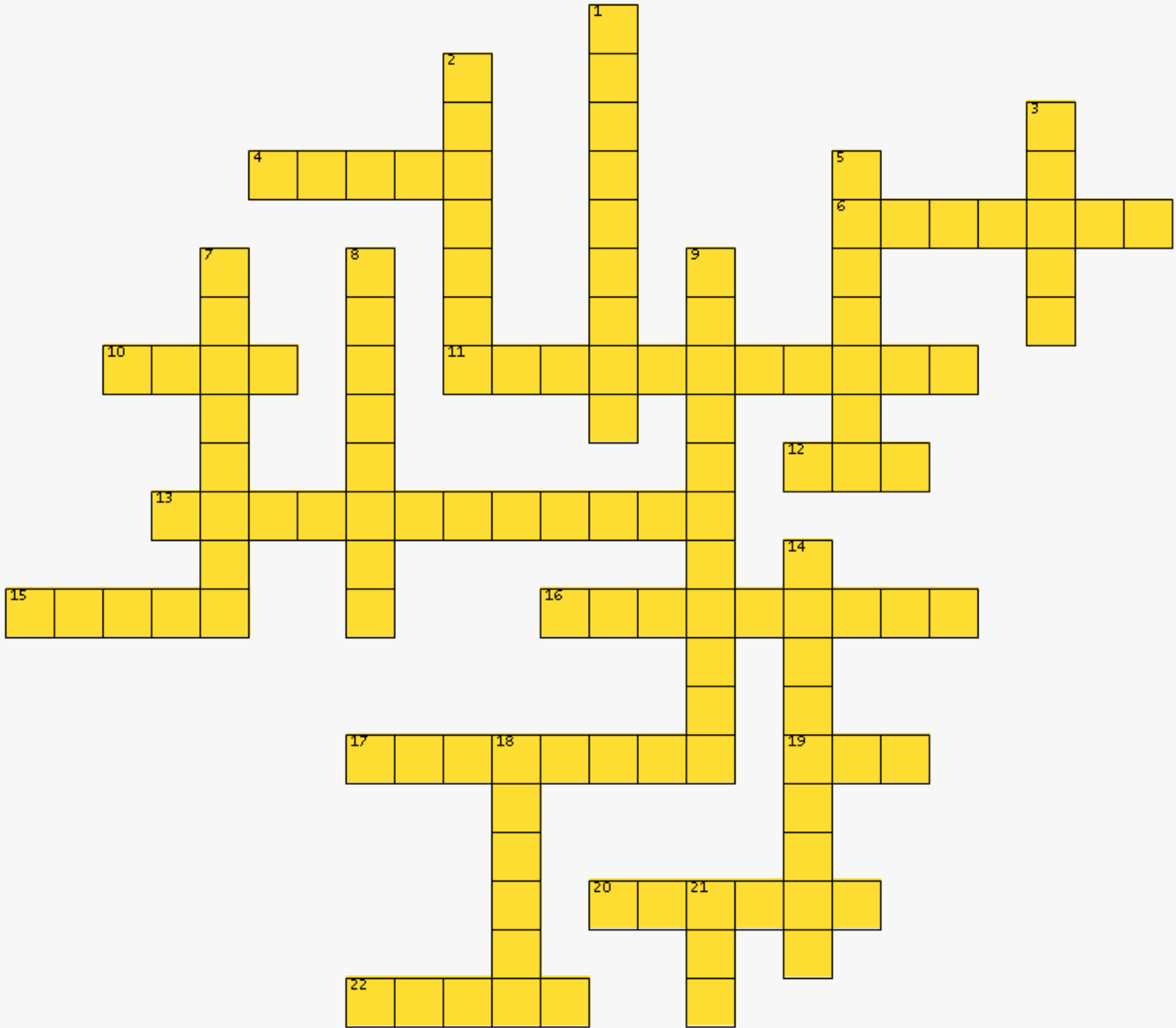


Viral Hepatitis
