

AN OVERLOOKED HEALTH DISPARITY

Hispanics are
60 percent more likely to die from viral hepatitis than whites.






Hispanics have low rates of reported cases of acute hepatitis C (9% in 2018) **HOWEVER...** Hispanics have relatively highrates of hepatitis C-related deaths.



In 2018, the rate of hepatitis C-related deaths for Hispanics was **4.64**, higher than the overall national rate of 3.72.



Chronic liver disease and cirrhosis is **number seven of the causes of death among Hispanics**, compared to 12th among whites, and 15th among blacks.



Ranking of chronic liver disease and cirrhosis among the **Top 10 causes of mortality** for Hispanics by gender and age.
